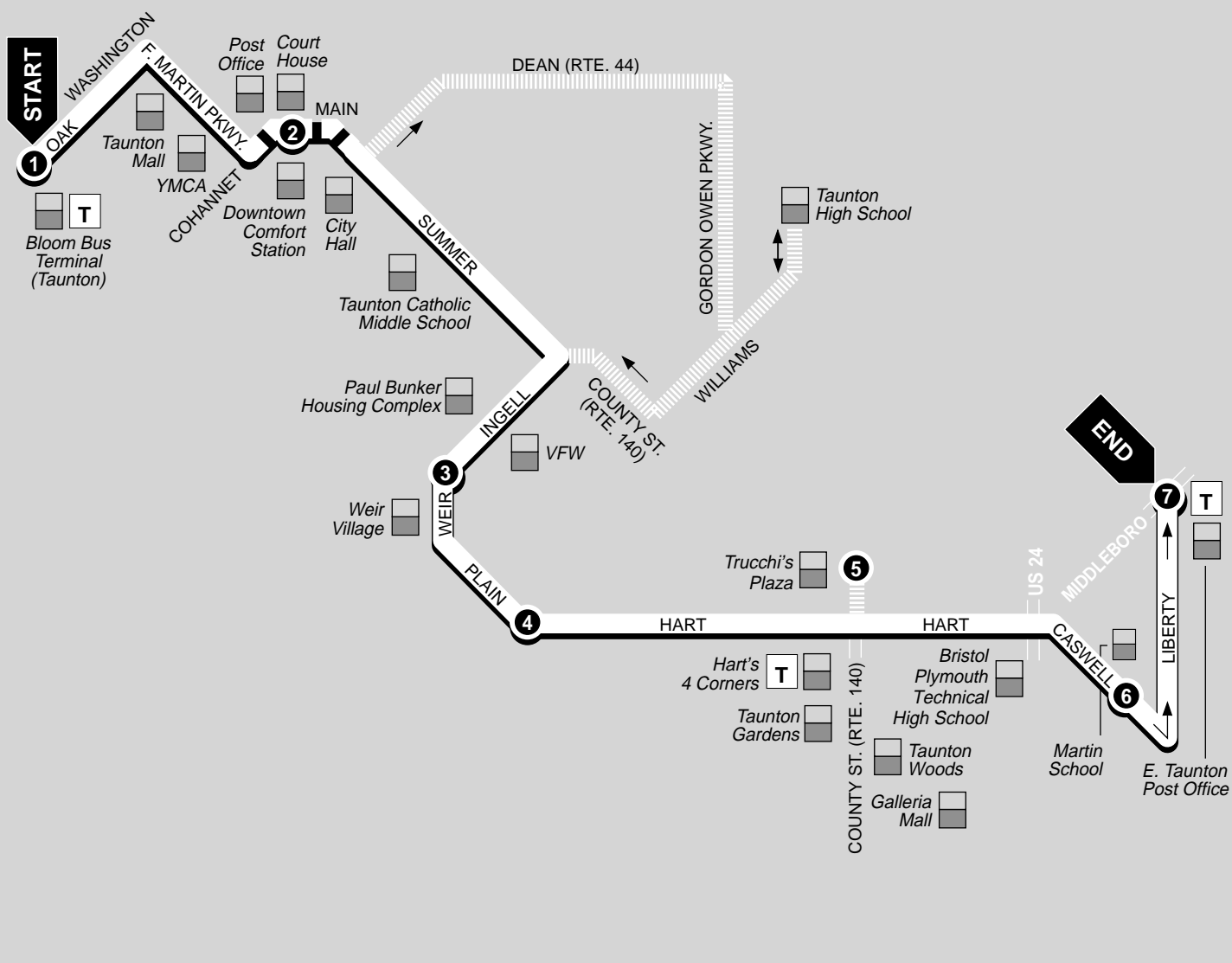

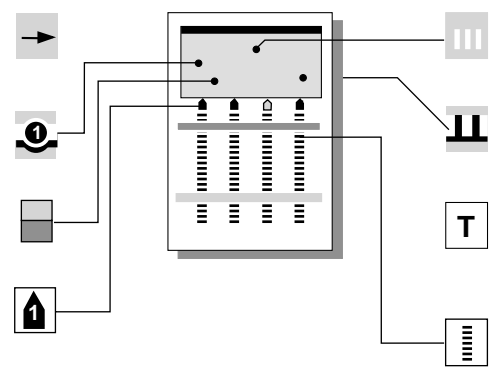
**INSTRUCTIONS**

The route always runs from left to right. The map and timetable are also read from left to right.

The bus stops here at listed times. Look for the matching symbol below the map.

Destinations & Landmarks.

The bus stops at each of the times listed below the symbol.



The bus loops here sometimes. Tip: Look for questions and answers below the map.

Passengers don't get on or off the bus during a NO STOP ZONE except at designated stops.

Indicates transfer points for buses traveling in the same area.

The timetable shows WHEN the bus stops. Times are always approximate, and depend upon traffic and weather conditions.

Statewide access passes for individuals with disabilities are issued by GATRA. The access pass offers half-fares on public bus transportation systems throughout Massachusetts, including GATRA.
