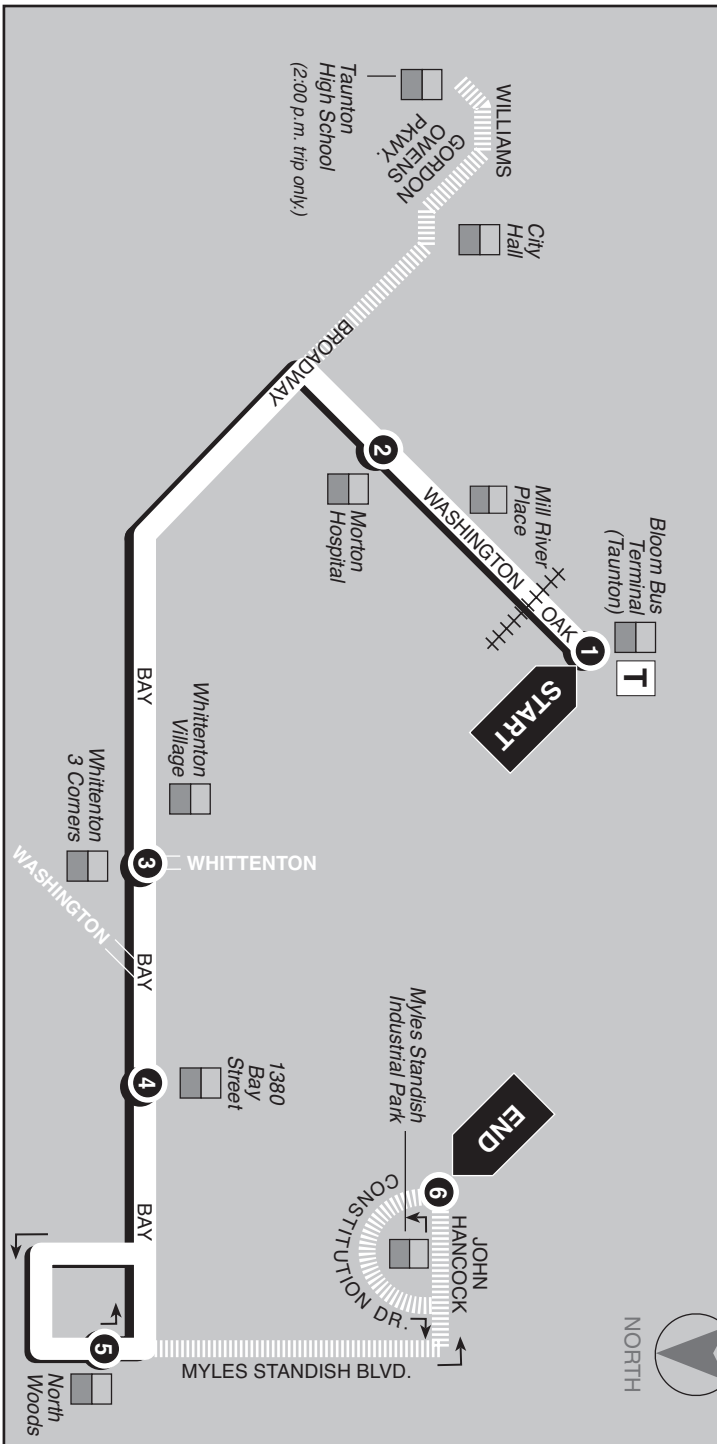

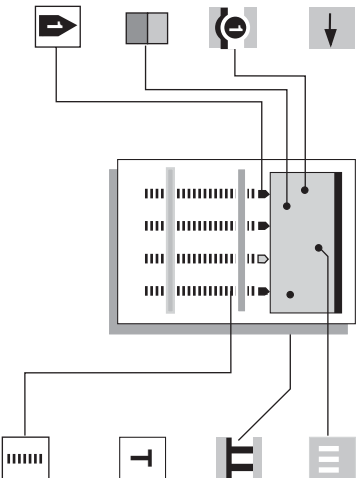
**INSTRUCTIONS**

**The route always runs from left to right.** The map and timetable are also read from left to right.

**The bus stops here at listed times.** Look for the matching symbol below the map.

**Destinations & Landmarks.**

**The bus stops at each of the times listed below the symbol.**



**The bus loops here sometimes.** See schedule.

**Passengers don't get on or off the bus during a NO STOP ZONE except at designated stops.**

**Indicates transfer points for buses traveling in the same area.**

**The timetable shows WHEN the bus stops.** Times are always approximate, and depend upon traffic and weather conditions.

**FARE INFORMATION**

GATRA buses are equipped with electronic fareboxes. Exact fare is strongly suggested. Please do not ask the driver for change, as they are not permitted to handle fares. No cash is returned from the farebox. Change is given in the form of stored value cards for future rider usage ONLY and is not redeemable for cash. Fares are non-refundable and non-transferable.

**Cash Fares**

Elderly (over 60) .....	\$.50

Students (through High School only, ID required)....	\$.50
Children (6 & under, with adult) .....	FREE

**Transfer (within one town only)**

**One Day Pass (within one town only)**
