Responsibilities

- Removes, cleans, repairs, reinstalls, and adjusts vehicle components (Engine emission components, driveline components, electrical/electronic components, bus and car air conditioning, brakes, suspension, steering, exhaust, cap, chassis and hydraulics)
- Ensures work orders are completed properly and accurately
- Selects appropriate course of action for repairs
- Evaluates completed work prior to release - seeks supervisor approval where required.
- Ensures safe use of power and hand-held tools
- Performs road calls and emergency services as necessary
- Moves vehicles safely between job and work area
- Communicates professionally with team members, and supervisors

Requirements
